

Centenary Fundraising Appeal

As well as celebrating and giving thanks for the last 100 years, we are also looking ahead to the next 100 years, and beyond. To make sure St.Giles is still around in 100 years time, we are undertaking vital fundraising towards restoration and updating of the church building, which sadly now requires extensive renovation, to preserve it for future generations.

The first stage of our fundraising is to mark the occasion with a visible remembrance of the past 100 years, and are looking ahead by restoring two heritage lamp posts in the churchyard at the front of St. Giles, which currently do not work. We want to restore them, add new electrics and Georgian lanterns to light the way for the next 100 years. As the work is done we will also be burying a Time Capsule filled with photos of people who have a connection to Rowley.
